

Connell Church of the Nazarene - Community Garden 2011



Guidelines

Hours: The community garden is open for gardeners to work during daylight hours.

Watering: Your rental fees cover the cost of reasonable use of water. All gardeners must remain in the garden while their plot is being watered. Water will only be available during watering hours (posted in the garden). Accommodations can be made for gardeners who are unable to be present during watering hours due to work.

Weeds and Trash: It is the gardener's responsibility to control the weeds and trash in their own plots and adjacent pathways. All trash and dead plant material must be taken with you unless a composting area is provided within the garden area.

Activity that Promotes Community: Smoking, alcohol, profanity, yelling or loud music are not permitted in the garden area.

Children: Children must be supervised at all times in the garden.

Pets: With the exception of service animals, pets are not allowed in the garden.

Harvesting: No one may pick or harvest another's plot without prior approval by the plot user.

Participation in communal work-days: The community garden depends upon volunteers for its success. We encourage your participation in work days such as spring and fall cleanup days, construction tasks, and other projects.

Food donations to the Community: In the spirit of giving back to the community, it is expected that gardeners donate approximately 10% or more of their garden plot produce to the local food bank, neighbors, or taken to local community events or churches for distribution.

Chemical use: Pesticides and herbicides are not permitted for use in garden. All fertilizers must be approved by the community garden Master Gardener.

Tools: Gardeners are responsible for providing their own hoses, tools, & garden equipment.

End of season: Gardeners are required to remove all material from their plot including plant materials, weed block, pots, cages, stakes, tools, etc. Failure to complete the season ending clean up with forfeiture applicant's ability to receive garden plots in the future.

Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Release

I am fully aware of the special dangers and risks inherent in this activity, including but not limited to, the risk of serious physical injury, other harmful consequences, even death, that may arise or result directly or indirectly to me from my participation in this activity. Being fully informed as to these risks, I hereby assume all risk of injury, damage, liability and harm to myself arising from such activities. I also hereby individually and on behalf of my heirs, executors and assigns, release and hold harmless the Connell Church of the Nazarene, their officials, employees, agents, and all Community Garden Partners and waive any right of recovery that I might have to bring a claim or lawsuit against them for any personal injury, death, or other consequences occurring to me arising out of my occupancy and/or use of the Community garden program.

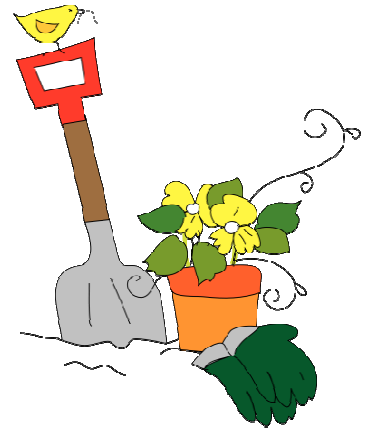
